

2015 CIRCUIT PRIZES

CENTRAL QUEENSLAND JUNIOR MASTERS CIRCUIT

MAJOR PRIZE: All winners of the 11/16, 13/16, 15/16 & 17/16 will receive a voucher to the value of \$200.00 only one prize per player. A bonus of \$100 goes to the player who wins both the circuit and the finals. If the Circuit and the Final is won by the same player the 2nd placed player on points (2 x A+, 1A, 1B & 1C) will receive a \$100 voucher. These vouchers are to be used for Tennis related activities.

CQ CIRCUIT: The lending boy and girl on points at the conclusion of the circuit in the 17, 15, 13 & 11 age groups will represent the circuit in the "QLD JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT SERIES FINALS" to be played at Rockhampton on 17/18 October, 2015. A manager/coach will accompany the team.

Players have to play the following events (in one age group) to qualify for the Major Prize: **two A+, one A, one C and one B (ITN) Event.** The player's best results in each of these categories will be used to determine the winner. If players have equal points, then their "head to head" results will be used to determine the winner. Although it is compulsory to play (one) B (ITN) event to win the Major Circuit prizes, **No points will be awarded in the these Events.**

CQ CIRCUIT FINAL: To qualify, players must play a minimum of **four circuit tournaments, ITN Events are counted as Circuit tournaments.** The boy and girl winners of the zone finals in age groups 17, 15, 13 and 11 will also represent the circuit at the "QLD JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT SERIES FINALS". If the winner of the finals is the same player as the winner of the circuit, the runner up of the circuit will represent the circuit at the "QLD JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT SERIES FINALS".

PLAYER OF MONTH: Six, monthly grants of \$100 towards tennis related cost eg. Coaching, will be awarded to players during the circuit finals. This award is flexible in application in that it may be given for winning but may also be presented for reasons such as good sportsmanship, behaviour, improvement, etc. To be considered for player of month/year awards the player must have competed in at least five circuit tournaments.

PLAYER OF YEAR: At the completion of the circuit, a player of the year grant of \$500 towards tennis related cost, eg. Coaching, will be awarded in addition to the Garrah Wroe Memorial Cup.

Old Regional Junior Teams (Brisbane December) will be selected based on the position the players finished on the qualifying points in the CQ Junior Masters Circuit, ie the Best Results for 2x A+, 1 x A, 1 x C and B (ITN Event).

Lucky Players Prizes: 8 Lucky Players prizes will be awarded at each CQ Junior Masters Circuit event in 2015. These lucky player prizes will be distributed evenly amongst each age group. These prizes will be given to players who have not won major prizes at the event.

Sportmanship Awards: A players at each CQ Junior Masters Circuit events will be selected to win a sportmanship award. This award will be selected by CQ Junior Masters Committee.



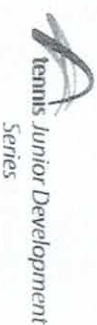

TOURNAMENT RULES AND CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- The tournament committee managing the tournament shall have the entire control of the tournament except for matters designated to the referee.
- The tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the laws of the game as set down by Tennis Australia.
- No entry fee shall be refunded unless the event is cancelled due to lack of entries or a player withdraws due to extenuating circumstances.
- Used balls may be supplied for all round matches. New balls to be used for finals.
- Lights will be used at the discretion of the committee.
- All players in 10/u, 11/u & 13/u will automatically be entered in both singles and doubles (No exception all players must play doubles). All players in the 15/u & 17/u events may play singles and doubles or two singles. Girls wishing to play the boys singles in the 17/u age must also play the 17/u girls singles. 13/u players will not be permitted to play in the 17/u age group singles. **10/u Age Group will use new green ball.**
- Players must be of the relevant age as at December 31 2015.
- In 17/U events with small nominations mixed singles may be played.
- Players are reminded that all entries should be sent by **Email, Phone, Fax or Post** and must be in the hands of the Tournament organisers by the **Monday** evening preceding the event or your name may not be included in the draw.
- In events with four or less entries, runner-up trophies may not be awarded.
- Players will be forfeited if unavailable to play at the scheduled time. No exceptions will be made. All 17/U Boys, 13/u Boys & 15/u Girls players are required at 8.00am on the Saturday morning of every tournament. All other players are required to attend by 8.30am. At ITN Events all players are required by 8.00am unless other instructed.
- Players (except 10/u age group) will be allocated points dependant on their progress through the draw (i.e.) Winner - 75, Runner-up - 50, 3rd - 40, 4th - 35, 5th - 30, 6th - 25, 7th - 20, 8th - 15, 9th - 10, 10th - 5.
- The Tennis Australia & Member Association Code of Conduct Policy will be observed at all times.
- All players must be registered with their State or National association. Where the committee has any doubts about the registration status of a player, that player shall be required to pay Tennis Queensland Registered Persons fee or be disqualified.
- Players shall be seeded by the Central Qld Junior Masters Circuit Committee

2015 Circuit Rules & Conditions

To all Junior Masters Tournament Organisers

Firstly Happy New Year and I hope all associations enjoy a great 2015 season.

- ψ Qualifying to be eligible to play the final is four tournaments. **Note*** Age eligibility is at 31/12/2015 not uncommon birth date as is now appropriate to Open Age Tournaments.**
- ψ To qualify for circuit prizes, e.g. such as Circuit Prizes (11/u, 13/u 15/u & 17/u) and Player of Year/Month & Sportsmanship Awards (all age groups) players must play at least five circuit events.
- ψ To win an age group players must play in five tournaments in that age group in the correct categories. 2x A+, 1xA,, 1xC plus 1 B (ITN) event.
- ψ All tournaments of 60 players and over must pay \$6.00 per entry and tournaments with less than 60 players must pay \$4.00 levy to the CQ Junior Masters Committee. This must be paid and returned with results within 14 days of completion of event.
- ψ All tournaments in the Wide Bay region are requested that seedings be done by Murray Whitbread, all events in CQ to be seeded by Andrew Selff and all Central Highlands events by Glenn Vickery. The phone numbers of the seeding committee is listed on the entry form. **Head Balls are to be used in all events. Green balls for the 10/u age groups.**
- ψ In events which have four or less entries runner-up trophies may not be awarded. This decision is up to individual clubs.
- ψ The first matches at every A+, A & C Category junior masters tournament in **2015 will be the 13/u & 17/u boys and 15/u girls** singles and they are required to attend by 8.00am Saturday Morning. All tournaments start at 8.00am Saturday and Sunday morning unless time is lost on first day and in this case play may start earlier on day 2. All these players who have not attended by 8.15 unless a bye has been awarded or not required to play should be forfeited. **In ITN B Category events all players must attend by 8.00am.**
- ψ Players in the 13/u, 11/u & 10/u events will automatically be entered into both singles and doubles events (no exceptions. Only players in the 15/u

age groups will be permitted to play in the 17/u singles events as a second singles event.

ψ **The recommended cost of trophies** is \$20 for singles winners, \$12 for singles runners-up, \$12.00 each for doubles winners and \$8.00 each for doubles runners-up. Trophies for feed-in winners are at the discretion of each club. The 10/u age group is different with event winners to receive a small trophy and all other participants will receive a small prize provided by CQJMC and a participation certificate which will have the singles and doubles position recorded. **In ITN B Category event the trophies will be the same cost with no vouchers awarded.**

ψ All Central Representative teams will be selected by best 5 results (A+,A,B & C)

ψ **All tournaments are required to vote on the Sportsmanship award** and this form must be returned with the levy form and results form at the completion of the event. The winners e.g. all four players awarded points at the event will be presented with a small prize at the event. These prizes will be supplied by the CQJMC.

- **IMPORTANT FOR ROUND ROBINS – (to be adhered to by all tournament directors for all round robins to achieve regional cohesion)**

Winners are determined by:

- most number of wins
- if wins same then sets for and against
- or games for and against (depending whether sets or 1st to 9)
- if all equal then head to head

Good luck to all tournaments and I hope everyone supports as many events as possible to make the 2015 circuit a huge success. All tournaments will receive an allocation of **Head** prizes to be distributed amongst participants who have not won trophies. Tournaments can rely on receiving at least 8 prizes. These prizes are to be distributed amongst players who have not won trophies (Lucky Losers) one prize for each event in the 11/u, 13/u, 15/u & 17/u boys & girls age groups. Tournament will also receive an allocation of participation prizes for the 10/u players as well as prizes for the Sportsmanship Awards.
